- 3. 2021 Winter Draft will start Wednesday December 1, 2021. Same format as usual, off-line draft with timed picks.

Player Raises (normal as per Constitution)

All players with MLB experience: Raise is 40% of current salary or \$3, whichever is greater. For simplicity, players that are \$8 or below will get a \$3 raise.

The following players with no MLB experience will receive a raise of \$2 (either as a keeper or as a Winter Draftee if not kept):

### **Rule Changes/Constitution Update**

Rule notes for 2022, assuming regular 162-game MLB season schedule:

- Position eligibility rules for 2022 will revert to regular rules
  - Hitters and RPs need 10 games in 2021 or 5 games in 2022
  - SPs need 5 starts in 2021 or 2 starts in 2022
- Injured slots we will make a determination prior to 2022 season regarding 4 or 5 injured slots. Will depend on pandemic conditions. Normal rule is 4 slots.

Adding rule regarding Holds to Constitution (use CBS method, which does not award a Hold for pitchers who enter before 6<sup>th</sup> inning).

Adding rule regarding End of NABL Regular Season – NABL will declare our playoff teams before resumption of any suspended MLB games.

#### **Divisional Re-Alignment**

Methodology – I ranked all twelve teams in order of average roto points over the past three seasons (which is when Texas Leaguers joined). Teams were paired off 1-2, 3-4, etc. 11-12. Each pair was separated randomly.
